Use this worksheet as an exercise to learn difficult vocabulary, and/or get a better understanding of a word. Items include:

- **vocabulary word** (small center box)
(e.g.: "cow")
- **definition/brief description** (large upper box)
(e.g.: "a domestic mammal, or the mature female of cattle of the genus *Bos*")
- **Properties or characteristics or attributes that would help you recognize it:** (right hand column)
(i.e.: Usually 4-5 feet tall; various colors--white, brown, reddish, black; found on farms; raised for its milk or meat; may have horns; feeds on grasses)
- **Examples that would be recognized as one of that "group"** (left hand column)
(Guernsey, brown and white breed from the island of Guernsey raised for milk;
Angus, black hornless breed from Scotland raised for meat;
Holstein, black and white breed from Germany/Holland raised for milk)
